Its main activities concern historical research, cultural heritage and contemporary art and culture, where artists, curators, academics contribute and cooperate.</p> <p>Having as main inspiration the cultural and historical impact of the Corinthian currant across European ports during 19th and 20th century, Primarolia organisation activates and implements interdisciplinary and intermedia collaborations and intercultural projects with public bodies, cultural and academic institutions. The annual extroversion of Primarolia organisation takes place through the homonymous Primarolia Festival, which presents creative symposia/workshops of historical research and developmental culture, contemporary collaborations with cultural and academic institutions in common projects, various events of music, theatre, cinema, installations and - as its major event - a curated contemporary art exhibition with invited artists from Greece and abroad who present experimental new works inspired by the local identity and Corinthian currant histories.</p>
